# Administrative Regulation 6141.2 Approved 12/12/19

## **Instruction**

#### **Recognition of Religious Beliefs and Customs**

Upon written request of the parent/ guardian, a student shall be excused from any part of health, family life, or sex education which conflicts with the religious training, beliefs, or personal moral convictions of the parent/guardian or student. (Education Code 51240)

Alternate activities shall be provided for students who are so excused.

### **Scheduling of School Events:**

- 1. Staff shall make every effort to schedule one-time events, such as examinations, school-sponsored trips, special laboratories, picture-taking days, and class parties, to minimize conflicts with major religious holidays of all faiths.
- 2. Program and activity planners shall take into consideration the diverse religious faiths represented in the community, student body, and staff.
- 3. School sites within the district reserve the right to postpone events and modify scheduled events as needed at the discretion of the Superintendent or designee.

<u>Programs and Exhibits:</u> When school programs and exhibits are in any way related to instruction about religion or religious holidays, the following guidelines shall be observed:

- 1) The principal or designee shall ensure that school-sponsored programs are not, or do not have the effect of being, religiously oriented or a religious celebration.
- 2) The principal or designee shall participate in planning the program or exhibit and shall be kept informed of its development.
- 3) Program or exhibit planners shall take into consideration the diverse religious faiths represented in the community, student body, and staff.
- 4) Students and staff whose beliefs prohibit their participation in a program shall be excused without penalty, and an alternate activity shall be provided for any such students.
