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TK – K: Information for Newcomers

Welcome to Mendocino K8 School! For many of you this is a first-time school experience and for others you have been through kindergarten with another child. The transition from preschool to kindergarten/transitional kindergarten (TK) can sometimes be difficult for students and parents. Below is a list of things to remember:

Students are eligible for TK if they turn five between September 2nd and April 2nd.

Mendocino K8 School highly values a child's social-emotional competence along with academic fluency. A child's social-emotional competence influences current school achievement and is predictive of future academic learning (Thompson and Goodman 2009).

Check your child's backpack daily for papers and information from the school!

The Paw Print is a newsletter that is published monthly. Hard copies are sent home with the students and an electronic copy is posted on ParentSquare.

All school communications happen through ParentSquare. Go to ParentSquare.com to register your account or download the ParentSquare app. The email you provide the school upon registering your child for school will be the one used for ParentSquare.

Attendance/Tardies

TK and kindergarten are programs that run five day a week. See below for times.

Mendocino K8 School: TK 8:30 – 12:15; kindergarten 8:30 – 2:20

Albion School: TK & kindergarten 8:00 – 12:15

Comptche School: TK & kindergarten 8:00 – 12:15

It is very important to have your child to school on time! If you aim for 8:25, that will give you a little cushion. It can be difficult for students to transition into a classroom after school has already started and it definitely interrupts the class when students



come in late. Often check-ins and instructions are missed when a child is late. Tardy students need to check into the office.

After 3 tardies, you will receive a letter from the school warning you of our concern.

We expect students to achieve at least 90% attendance in school. That means students miss less than two days per month, 18 days for the year. The state reports that the average number of students who are truant (< 90% attendance) across California in 2016-17 was 10.8%. Mendocino K8 School had an average of 19.4% of students truant that same year with kindergarten students being the most truant.

If your student misses school, please contact the office.

Early Bedtime and Established Routines

Keeping an early bed time and establishing routines around going to bed and getting up for school can help with the transition to TK/kindergarten. All children are different in the amount of sleep they need but, know they will be working hard and growing fast during their first couple of years of school and adequate sleep is necessary for success! Look for signs of fatigue, crying, unusual behavior, etc. for children who might need more sleep. Some studies suggest between 10 and 12 hours of sleep for children four to five years of age.

Registration

In order to register for TK/kindergarten in Mendocino schools, you will need to provide proof of residency and immunizations. This could be a lease agreement, deed, or electric bill in your name. Please bring proof of residency and immunizations to the office before June 28th. This way you will be pre-registered in our system and August registration will run more smoothly.

A Registration Day will be held on August 24th, 10:00 – 2:00 for Mendocino, Comptche, and Albion school sites. Registration will be completed online. You will need to print and sign the emergency card at the end of online registration and return it to the office. Registration day is a family event and students are encouraged to come! Registration day is also our official school picture day.

Immunizations

All TK/kindergarten students must be immunized before beginning school on August 28th.
