AE Week Sign-Ups

AE Week provides students a unique opportunity for learning beyond the classroom. This year will mark Mendocino High School's 32nd Alternative Education Week. The longevity of this program is a testament to its educational value.

Students are encouraged to make their selections based on their interests. No student will be denied participation based on an inability to pay. While some fundraising may be necessary, Site Council has set aside funding to help support AE Week programs and students and MUSE provides generous donations as well.

Alternative Education Week is a two credit course. All students must participate. Students will receive Credit (2 credits) for participation and No Credit (0 credits) for no participation, which will appear on student transcripts. Students who violate the school's drug and alcohol policies in the second semester will not be allowed to attend overnight trips. Behaviour may also dictate eligibility for certain trips.

Friday, November 8: Brochure featuring activities is distributed to students. Students will be emailed a google form to sign up.

Wednesday, November 13: Google forms are due. Students must select their top 4 choices by this date.
